Take Action for World Polio Day: 24 October

Every year, Rotary members around the world mobilize for [World Polio Day](#). We raise awareness of polio and gather support for our global effort to make sure that every child is protected from it.

By staying tenacious, hopeful, and committed, we *will* make history by making polio the second human disease ever to be eradicated.



How you can take part in World Polio Day

Host an event or activity. The Rotaract Club of Samaro, Sindh, Pakistan, conducted a polio awareness session to educate parents about polio and its effects on children. The club provided educational materials and gifts for the children.

Plan a fundraiser. Rotarian Jason Browne partnered with Raids of Love, a community of gamers dedicated to doing good, to host “Gamers to End Polio” charity streams on Twitch, YouTube, Facebook, and Kick. They raised over US\$4,000 for PolioPlus and also educated viewers on polio and Rotary’s PolioPlus initiative. Learn more about this fundraiser by watching the first [Voices of Members video](#).

Post on social media. Use the materials on the [World Polio Day Resources page](#) to spread the word about World Polio Day and the importance of polio eradication. Don’t forget to use the hashtags #EndPolio and #WorldPolioDay!

Public Image

BEFORE THE EVENT:

Publicise the planned World Polio Day event. Get assistance from you're your district/club public image committee. Work as a team. Produce flyers. Broadcast the event in social media, short messaging, websites, radio, print media etc.



Think if it is worth doing paid 'advertorials' in the social media so that the information about the event will reach new audiences.

How about getting social media influencers to work as the 'event ambassador' for your event to boost awareness & participations as well as to boost followers?

DURING THE EVENT:

Work with district/club public image committee to take videos, photos during the event for letting your community and the world know that end polio eradication is Rotary's #1 external priority. Rotary and partner organisations have reduced polio by 99.9%. Capitalise on the event to use the videos and photos to portray to public that Rotarians are People of Action. Use [Rotary Brand Center](#) with images taken from your event to produce localised materials and images.

AFTER THE EVENT:

Work with your District/Club Rotary Foundation Committee (and District/Club Fund Raising/PolioPlus Committee) and the District/Club Public Image Committee to continue to publish information on the progress of polio eradication. This is especially important for the donors.

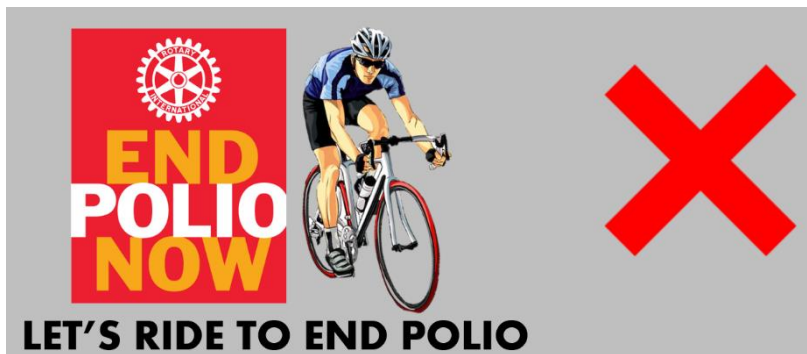
USING BRAND COMPLIANT LOGO



This End Polio Now logo does not have the Rotary wheel in it. Therefore, it cannot be used alone. It has to be used with the Masterbrand Signature of the club or district nearby so that our audiences will be aware that this initiative is associated with Rotary.



This End Polio Now logo can be used alone. Anyone seeing this logo will be aware that Rotary is associated with the polio eradication initiative.



Minimum Clear Space Surrounding Logos

Any additional text or graphics to be placed surrounding the logo can only be placed with minimum clear space between them.

This is to make sure that the logo is not obscured and our audiences do not have the impressions that those additional text/graphics are part of the logo.
